The goal of the **RISE7 Workshop** is to stimulate an in-depth discussion of a select number of empirical research papers. It offers **Ph.D. students and Junior Post-docs** an opportunity to present their work and to receive feedback.

The **RISE7 Workshop** welcomes papers from all areas of research on innovation, science of science and entrepreneurship, such as:

- Knowledge Diffusion
- Intellectual Property Rights
- Innovation Motives & Behavior
- Artificial Intelligence
- Environmental Innovation and Sustainability

The **RISE7 Workshop** will feature a keynote lecture and approx. 10 paper presentations. Each paper is discussed by a senior researcher with particular emphasis on the research design and the ability to identify causal relationships.
